Nicholas James Boggs 1929 - 2017

NICHOLAS JAMES BOGGS, 88, of Proctorville, OH, formerly of Huntington, WV, was called home to be with his Heavenly Father on January 20, 2017 after a long illness. Often known by his middle name, James, he was born in Huntington, WV on January 15, 1929, to the late James and Mattie Boggs. He was preceded in death by his wife of 46 years, Ada Charlotte Boggs. James was a devoted husband and father and put all of his energy into providing for his family. He was employed by Armco Steel as an electrician until his retirement in 1992. He accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at age 7 during the church anniversary of First Baptist Church. He graduated a semester early from Douglass High School and attended North Carolina A&T University. He served in the United States Army during the Korean War and earned the rank of Second Lieutenant. He loved watching sports, especially football and the Cleveland Browns were his favorite team. James enjoyed staying abreast of the stock market and financial issues by reading the newspaper from beginning to end and watching financial news programs on television. He had an impeccable memory and could randomly recount miscellaneous facts and events in detail.
