May Evelyn Gillette Suiter Hunt 1921 - 2017

May Evelyn Gillette Suiter Hunt, 95, of Proctorville, Ohio, passed away peacefully on Saturday, January 7, 2017, at Grant Rehabilitation and Care Center, Petersburg, WV. May was born on September 15, 1921, she was the daughter of the late Robert Preston "R. P." and Gertrude Belle King Gillette. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her first husband, Lt. Fleming Suiter, in 1946, her second husband, John Seva "Jackie" Hunt, in 1991, two brothers, Donald Oregon Gillette and William Harold Gillette, and two sisters, Mildred Rosalie Gillette Bailes and Gladys Gertrude "Dottie" Gillette Molter.
