Larry Keith O'Dell, Sr., 72, of Chesapeake, Ohio, formerly from St. Albans, West Virginia, passed into the presence of Christ while surrounded by his loving family after a lengthy and devastating descent into Lewy Body Dementia. Larry was born in Charleston, West Virginia, to the late Richard Nolan O'Dell and Vera Waldorf O'Dell on June 10, 1947. He was a graduate of South Charleston High School and West Virginia University. After working as an assistant store manager for Montgomery Ward and as a men's clothing buyer for Frankenbergers, he pursued a course of study at the Graduate Realtor Institute to develop a foundation of knowledge and skills for his employment with Old Colony Realty Company where he served in several different positions culminating as a mortgage broker and manager of the company's Mortgage Net. Foremost in his life was his relationship with Christ through which he examined and determined all of life's choices, found strength to endure and overcome life's challenges, and celebrate God's gifts of grace, mercy, and joy.
