Glenn Hoodlet Van Atta, 87, of Proctorville, Ohio, passed away Tuesday, May 28, 2019, at St. Marys Medical Center, Huntington. He was the youngest child of Frank and Hazel Van Atta, born November 27, 1931, in Logan, Ohio. He served both his country and community. He enlisted in the Air Force out of high school, serving in the Korean War. He later worked as a Police Officer in his hometown of Logan, later retiring from Dolan Supply Co. in Huntington, WV. Glenn was a beloved and devoted husband, father, grandfather, and great grandfather. He was preceded in death by his wife of over 60 years, Coletta, daughter Glenna Pflanz (Bill), and two sisters, Alice Hamilton and Frances Dodge and two brothers, George and Frank.
