## Raymond Michael Lamb

On the morning of June 26, 2024, Raymond Michael Lamb, 60, of Proctorville, Ohio, passed away peacefully at home following a long illness. Born on May 6, 1964, in Columbus, Ohio, Ray was born to Raymond Lamb and the late Eileen Marik Lamb of Reynoldsburg, Ohio. Retired from XPO logistics, where he worked as a supervisor, Ray was an avid sports fan who enjoyed spending time outdoors with family and friends. He attended Marshall University on an athletic scholarship, where he was a proud member of the 1983-1986 Thundering Herd football team. He passed his love of sports on to his children, Michael and Samantha; both participated in Fairland sports, where Ray served as a coach for many years.
