Steven Herbert Clark, devoted husband, loving father, and proud Papaw passed away Sunday June 28, 2020 at the age of 70 after a long battle with cancer. Steve made his last walk up the 18th fairway peacefully at home, with his family by his side. Steve was preceded in death by his father, Herb and his mother, Louise. He is survived by his wife Teresa, his children Derek (Tiffany) Clark of Cottontown, TN and Leslie Wolf of Cincinnati, OH, and numerous family and friends who meant the world to him.
