Having attended the McDowell County Public Schools, Shirley graduated from Gary District High School. She also, attended the Mercer County Career Center for certification as a seamstress. After marrying Gerald Leftwich in 1958, she moved to Bluefield, West Virginia. Together they were the parents of four children. They soon began pursuit of the "American Dream" through purchasing a home as well as launching their own business. She and her husband opened The Factory a restaurant and game room that catered largely to students from Bluefield State College.

Shirley Leftwich was baptized at an early age in the Church of Our Lord Jesus in Gary under the pastorate of the late Elder Posey Smith. In Bluefield she became a member of what is now Greater Mt. Zion Pentecostal Church under the pastorate of the late Bishop C. E. Moore.
