Marshall Lee Smith, 82, of Proctorville, Ohio passed away December 14, 2016. Marshall was born in Rome, Ohio to the late Lee Roy and Myrtie Pauline Smith on January 9, 1934. He attended Fairland High School, studied Engineering at Marshall University, and served in the United States Air Force during the Korean War. Marshall married Mary Lou Farris in 1957, and had two children, Gregory Lee and Dee Anna. Marshall started SCC, Inc., in the early 1960's, completing many commercial jobs in the eastern United States, and earning a reputation of integrity in the community. Marshall was an avid hunter, fisherman, and golfer. He loved watching his grandchildren and great grandchildren play sports and the highlight of his day was meeting with friends every morning at McDonalds. 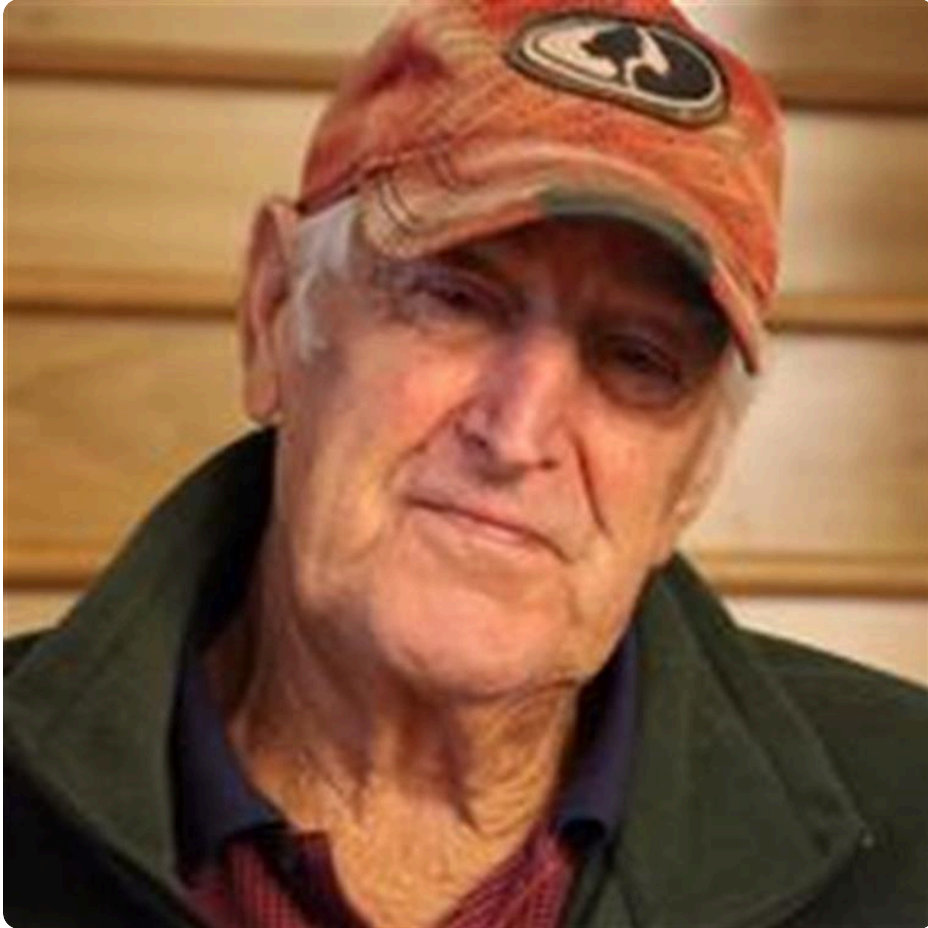
