Garnett Josephine Hall was a loving wife, mother, grandmother, sister, aunt, and friend. She passed away on February 16, 2022 surrounded by her beloved children.

Garnett was born on June 20, 1934 to Arthur and Nancy Fortner in Dry Ridge, Kentucky. After graduating high school, she began her nursing education at Bethesda Nursing School. While in school, she began dating Fred Talmadge Hall Jr who was active duty in the Navy. They delayed their marriage while he was away on a ship during the Korean War and opted for many love letters until they could be together again. Once reunited, they were happily married for 54 years. They started their life together in the Cincinnati area where she worked as a nurse and he as an electrician for the C&O Railroad. His work led them to Proctorville, Ohio where they started a family and raised five children together.

Anyone who knew Garnett would agree that the thing she treasured most was her family. Her hobbies and interests centered on her children. Until the day she died, she would have the same answer to the question "who is your favorite?" It was always "I love them all the same". Truer words were never spoken as she spent her life devoted to her family. Her door was always open to friends and neighbors and many considered her an extra mom. She worked as a school nurse at Fairland K-12 for 30 years. While working full time and raising children, she also returned to her nursing education to achieve a Master's in Nursing from the University of Cincinnati.
