Charles Leslie Copen age 88 went quietly to be with his Savior and Lord Thursday evening February 29, 2024 after a prolonged illness. His favorite verse was: 2 Timothy 1:12, For which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day. It is a loss for his family but, as the apostle Paul stated, "It was gain for him". He was known as Charles to his late mother, Helen, but he was known as "Chuck" to everybody else. Chuck left behind his immediate family ;his wife Roberta (Mickey), two daughters ; Leslie Copen-Roush (Terry Roush) and Pamela Copen. Before that he worked for a myriad of businesses from serving hotdogs at Stewarts to being a delivery driver for the Kenny Shoe company. He also served in the Army Reserve where he obtained the rank of Sergeant. He married his wife, Roberta Anderson, 68 years ago on Christmas Eve 1955. He was a very faithful attendee and active member of Grace Gospel Church since 1954. He served that church in the Bus Ministry, Awana, Child Evangelism and other local ministries for years.
