Paula married Charles E. Perry at 19 years old in December of 1968. Paula and Charlie resided in multiple places including Niles, Ohio; Fayetteville, North Carolina; Key West, Florida; Bad Tölz, Germany; Madison, Wisconsin; Monterey, California; and (again) Fayetteville, North Carolina before settling in the village of Crown City, Ohio in August of 1997.
